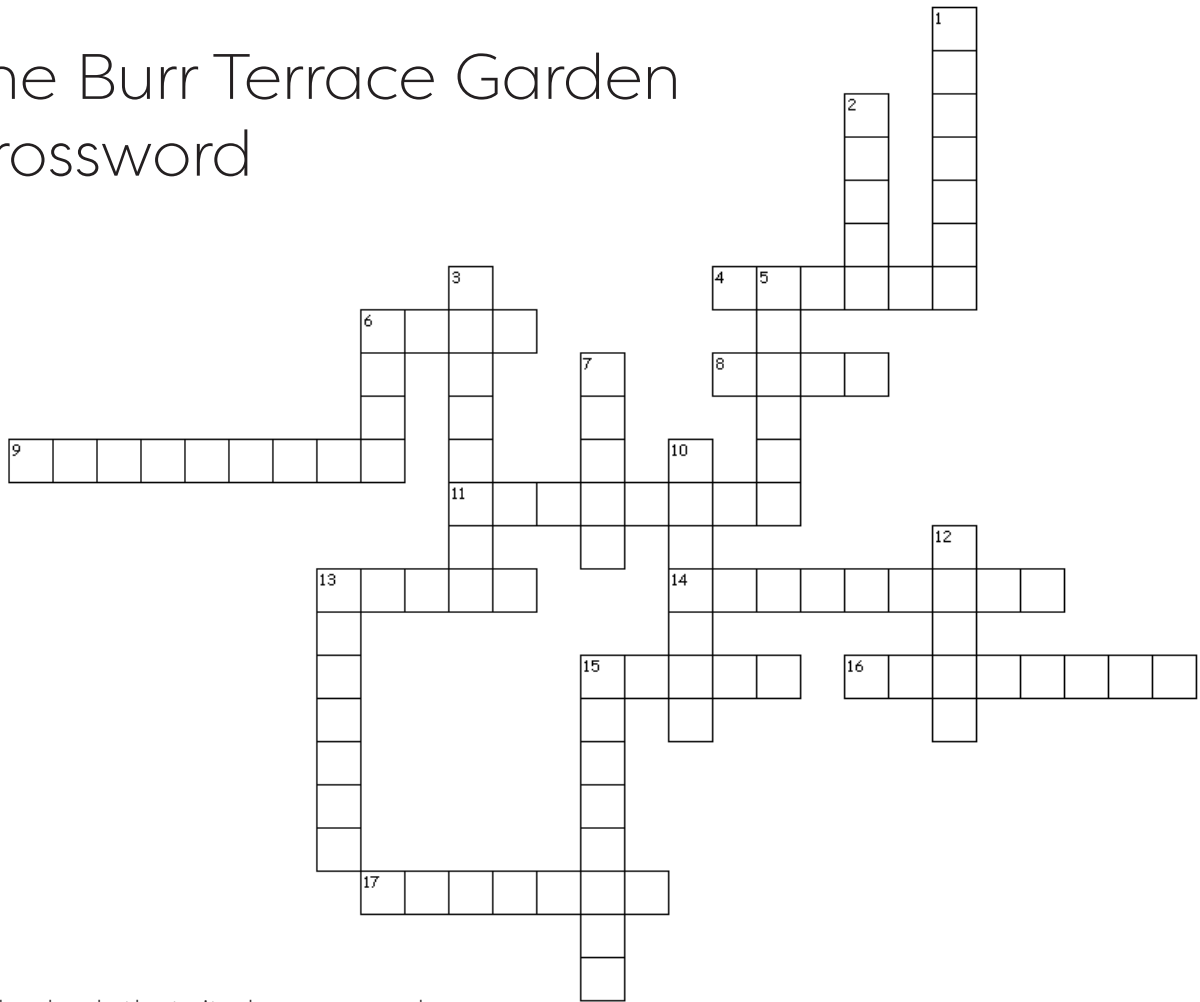


# The Burr Terrace Garden Crossword
