
A Place of Beauty and Inspiration.

With its intact and picturesque vistas, Cheekwood is distinguished as one of the leading Country Place Era estates in the nation. Formerly the family home of Mabel and Leslie Cheek, the 1930s estate today serves the public as a botanical garden, arboretum, and art museum. Located eight miles


southwest of downtown Nashville. the property includes 55 acres of cultivated gardens and the historic mansion. Cheekwood is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is accredited by the American Alliance of Museums and nationally as a Level II Arboretum.

Cited as an enduring symbol of the friendship between Tennessee and Japan, the Blevins Japanese Garden has been called one of the most original Japanese Gardens in North America and features a bamboo forest.





Inspired by Cheekwood's historic landscape and architecture, the **Bracken** Foundation Children's Garden offers children an interactive outdoor experience focused on imaginative play to inspire



The Ann & Monroe Carell Jr. Family Sculpture Trail features 13 outdoor monumental sculptures including works by Siah Armajani, Jenny Holzer and James Turrell among others along a 1.5-mile path.



Historic Mansion & Museum

The Historic Mansion & Museum is one of Nashville's most desirable and elegant venues. Surrounded by lush, formal gardens the mansion was originally the home of Leslie and Mabel Cheek. Built in 1929 by architect Bryant Fleming, it features period rooms with authentic furnishings and art galleries on the upper floors.

Rent out the entire Historic Mansion & Museum for a lavish corporate celebration, or reserve individual rooms and spaces for smaller events. The space is ideal for groups from 20-400.

The rental of the Historic Mansion & Museum includes both indoor and outdoor spaces, including use of Cheekwood's pristine Swan Lawn, Loggia, Wisteria Arbor and even access to the art galleries. With vast



Frist Learning Center

In addition, this space offers brand new smaller meeting rooms to accommodate large groups seeking break-out areas. The Frist Lawn, available for open-aired events, is behind the Frist Learning Center and has a view of the eastern slope of the Cheekwood Mansion, featuring a stone wall and lush trees.



Conveniently located at the Frist Learning Center is Cheekwood's own Café 29. This is a convenient dining option for small daytime meetings. Café 29 offers a casual, madeto-order menu, Maxwell House coffee selections and alcoholic beverages. The café also features picnic options for those needing a creative break in the gardens.




Great Hall and Terrace






Massey Auditorium


